EC Scholars

The university's most prestigious scholarship program, the EC Scholars award provides students with a four-year merit scholarship while they participate in research projects, internships, leadership development, and a required study-abroad experience.

As an EC Scholar, you will receive not only the benefits of the Honors College but also the following:

- The EC Scholars Award, valued at \$10,000 per year for up to four years
- A \$5,000 stipend to complete a required study-abroad experience connected to your academic interests
- Leadership development series culminating with individualized internship placement
- Research internship placement alongside faculty and graduate students
- Enrichment experiences in Charleston, South Carolina and Washington, D.C.
- Pre-college, team-building retreat in North Carolina's Outer Banks

Early Assurance Programs

Directed toward students who plan to enter a graduate-level health sciences program, East Carolina's Early Assurance Programs provide Honors students with opportunities in leadership, service, and research, as well as a guaranteed place in a graduate program years before they earn their undergraduate degree. Academic areas of focus include medicine, physical therapy, audiology, nursing and occupational therapy.
