




The Marine Corps Scholarship Foundation is the Nation's oldest and largest provider of need-based scholarships to military children. Since 1962, the Scholarship Foundation has provided more than 30,000 scholarships valued at over \$80,000,000 to the children of Marines and Navy Corpsmen, with particular attention to those whose parent has been killed or wounded in combat, or have demonstrated financial need.

We award scholarships for undergraduate college education in all 50 states and internationally. Our scholarship recipients study in a variety of academic disciplines. The Scholarship Foundation provides financial resources and the support of an extended community, ensuring the children of Marines and eligible Navy Corpsmen have the opportunity to attend college and successfully achieve their goals.



Eligibility Criteria

The Marine Corps Scholarship Foundation awards need-based scholarships to the children of the following:

- ★ Active Duty and Reserve U.S. Marines
- ★ Veteran U.S. Marines who have received an honorable discharge, or were killed while serving in the U.S. Marine Corps
- ★ Active Duty and Reserve U.S. Navy Corpsmen who are serving, or have served with a U.S. Marine Unit
- ★ Veteran U.S. Navy Corpsmen who have served with a U.S. Marine unit and have received an honorable discharge, or were killed while serving in the U.S. Navy

Additionally, applicants must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- ★ Planning to attend an accredited undergraduate college or vocational/technical institution in the upcoming academic year
- ★ A GPA of at least 2.0
- ★ An income requirement must be met
- ★ Special funding is available for the children of those who were wounded or killed in combat operations
